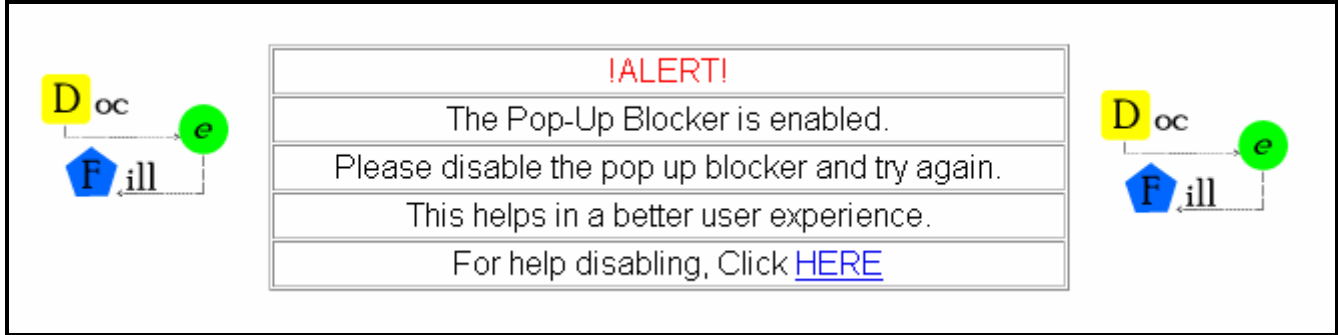


How to disable Pop up Blockers

All pop up blockers must be disabled before Doc e Fill can be launched. If the following screen opens and Doc e Fill does not launch, then a pop up blocker is activated.




Here are the steps on how to disable some of the popular toolbars that will prevent Doc e Fill from launching:

Google Toolbar:

The following image is what the Google Toolbar looks like on Internet Explorer:



If this toolbar is present on the Internet Explorer browser, then here are some ways to get Doc e Fill launched:

Method 1: Once the screen with the Alert message, mentioned above, opens, (left) click on the “# blocked”  image and Google Toolbar will allow pop ups at the correct site


Method 2: Remove the pop up blocker. Appendix A.


Yahoo Toolbar:

The following image is what the Yahoo Toolbar looks like on Internet Explorer:



If this toolbar is present on the Internet Explorer browser, then here are some ways to get Doc e Fill launched:

Method 1: Once the screen with the Alert message, mentioned above, opens, (left) click on the pop up alert  image. A menu will open, viewed in Figure 1. Click on the “Enable Pop-Up Blocker” checkmark to disable the pop up blocker

Method 2: Once the screen with the Alert message, mentioned above, opens, (left) click on the pop up alert  image. A menu will open, viewed in Figure 1. Click on the “Always Allow Pop-Ups From...” selection in the menu. The “Yahoo! Pop-Up Blocker” window will open, viewed in Figure 2. Select the

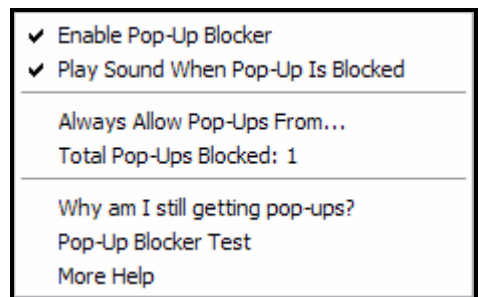

proper site from the “Sources of Recently Blocked Pop-Ups:” list and click on the “Allow” button on the right.

Method 3: Remove the pop up blocker. Appendix A.

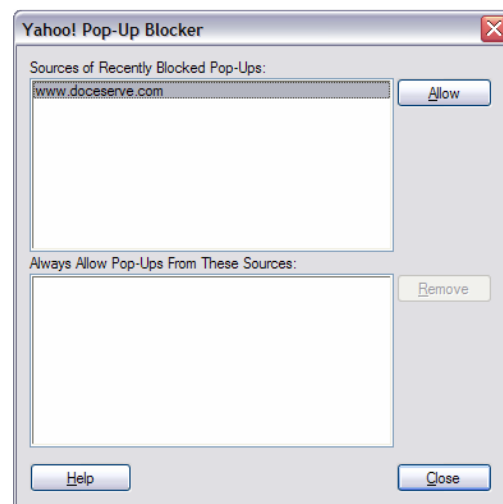
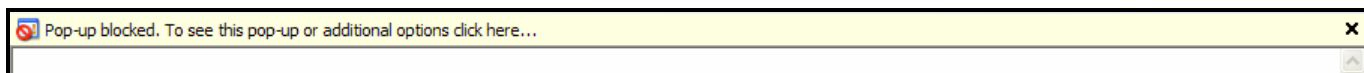

Internet Explorer Pop-up Blocker:

If there are no pop up blockers present on the Internet Explorer browser, then Internet Explorer pop up needs to be disabled. The following is how it will look if Internet Explorer has blocked a pop up:



This yellow bar will appear above the page. Here are some ways to disable the Internet Explorer pop up blocker:

Method 1: Click on the yellow bar that appears above the page, pictured above. A menu will open, viewed in Figure 3. Select the “Always Allow Pop-ups from This Site...” option. The confirmation window will open asking “Would you like to allow pop-ups from ...”, viewed in Figure 4. Click the “Yes” button and the window will refresh and open Doc e Fill.

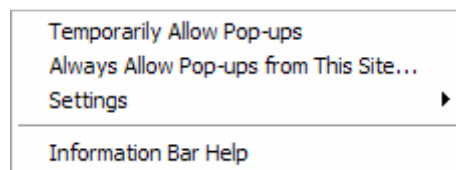

Method 2: Click on “Tools” from the menu bar and hover over “Pop-up Blocker”. Another menu will open to the right and select “Turn Off Pop-up Blocker”, viewed in Figure 5. The Internet Explorer pop up blocker will be turned off.

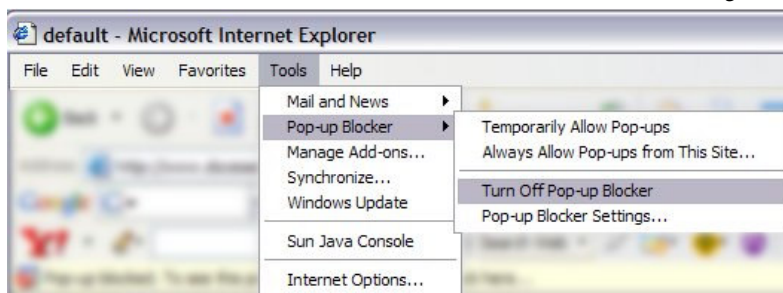


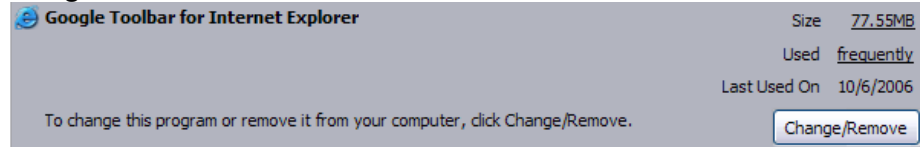

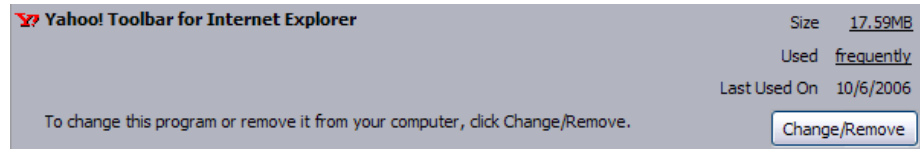
How to completely Remove Toolbars

1. Open "Add Remove Programs" found in the Control Panel.
2. Find any toolbars that need removing.

Google Toolbar:



Yahoo! Toolbar:



3. Click on the "Change/Remove" button. This will remove the toolbar from Internet Explorer
